Here's another warmup game called "What is it?".

This time there are 6 riddles about animals. See if you can guess the correct answer.

Are you ready? Have you got a pencil and a piece of paper? OK! Let's do it!

- 1.) This animal is black and white. It loves bamboo and it lives in China. What is it?
- 2.) This animal lives on the North Pole. It's white and very big. It can be as tall as 2.4 metres! What is it?
- 3.) This animal has a very long neck and long legs. It eats leaves, grass and fruit. It's the tallest land animal in the world and it lives in Africa. What is it?
- 4.) This animal is a bird, but it can't fly. It has wings but uses its wings for swimming. It eats fish and lives in colonies on the South Pole. What is it?
- 5.) This animal has a small head, but strong legs and large feet because it's very, very good at jumping. It can also swim. It carries its babies in a pouch. The babies are called joeys – yoooooo, joeys, isn't that sweet?! This animal lives in Australia. What is it?
- 6.) This animal looks like a horse, but it has black and white stripes. It lives in Africa and eats grass and leaves. What is it?

Now, I'll repeat the riddles so that this time you can check your answers.

- 1.) This animal is black and white. It loves bamboo and lives in China. Do you know what is it? That's right – it's a panda bear.
- 2.) This animal lives on the North Pole. It's white and very big. It can be as tall as 2.4 metres! Can you guess what is it? That's right – it's a polar bear.
- 3.) This animal has a very long neck and long legs. It eats leaves, grass and fruit. It's the tallest land animal in the world and it lives in Africa. What is it? Yes, it's a giraffe. Very good!

4.) This animal is a bird, but it can't fly. It has wings but uses its wings for swimming. It eats fish and lives in colonies on the South Pole. Do you know what is it? You're right – it's a penguin! Well done!

5.) This animal has a small head, but strong legs and large feet because it's very, very good at jumping. It can also swim. It carries its babies in a pouch. The babies are called joeys – yooooo, joeys, isn't that sweet?! This animal lives in Australia. What is it? Yes, it's a kangaroo. Very good!

6.) This animal looks like a horse, but it has black and white stripes. It lives in Africa and eats grass and leaves. Hmm, what is it? You're right – it's a zebra. Well done!
